CIRCLE THE SQUARE WITH PRAYER

The first Thursday in May will once again see many gathering in prayer for our nation. We are asking you to join us and many others on Public Square in Wilkes-Barre for Circle the Square with Prayer.

The National Day of Prayer was created in 1952 by a joint resolution of Congress, and signed into law by President Harry S. Truman. In 1988, the law was unanimously amended by both the House and the Senate and signed into law by President Ronald Reagan on Thursday, May 5, 1988, designating the first Thursday of May as a day of national prayer. Every president since 1952 has signed a National Day of Prayer proclamation.

The theme for the 2019 National Day of Prayer on May 2 is **Love One Another**. The theme comes from the words of Jesus in John 13:34, "Love one

another. Just as I have loved you."

Circle the Square with Prayer, on Public Square in Wilkes-Barre, is the local event in conjunction with hundreds of events held across the nation. Circle the Square with Prayer has included participation from over 40 local churches over the past several years.

The main event is a prayer service at 6 pm. The interactive corporate prayer service will offer the opportunity to pray and express the love of God with those gathered.





Jim and Elisabeth Elliot. Two names that are so well known to Christians today. In a new book, ***Devotedly, The Personal Letters and Love Story of Jim and Elisabeth Elliot***, their only daughter Valerie Elliot Shepard, gives us a glimpse into the personal side of their relationship. What many don't know is the remarkable story of how these two stalwart personalities—single-mindedly devoted to pursuing God's will for their young lives, certain their future callings would require them to sacrifice forever the blessings of marriage—found their hearts intertwined. Their paths to God's purpose led them together.

Through the personal correspondence and journal entries from both of her parents, Valerie has put together a moving account of their personal lives which shines as a gold mine of lived-out truth, hard-fought purity, and an insider's view on two beloved Christian figures.

Readers of Irene Hannon's Hope Harbor series will enjoy the fifth book in her series that takes place in the tiny Oregon seaside town of Hope Harbor, ***Driftwood Bay***. After tragedy upends her world, Jeannette Mason retreats to create a new life. She focuses on running her lavender farm and tea room, until a new neighbor with a destructive dog and a forlorn little girl invades her turf. Dr. Logan West is too busy coping with an unexpected family, a radical lifestyle change, and an unruly pup to have any interest in his aloof and disagreeable neighbor. When both Jeanette and Logan find themselves pulled into the life of a tattered Christian family fleeing persecution in war-torn Syria, they just might discover that love sometimes comes calling when it's least expected.
