To the WRGN listening family,

Last month, many across the nation watched as the two major political parties met for their conventions, one in Cleveland, the other in Philadelphia. For our family, the month of July was such that we didn't watch any of either! What did catch my eye though, was a video that predicted the end of the world on July 29th.

The prediction was based on a phenomena called a polar shift or flip, that a group said would trigger worldwide tremors setting off earthquakes and a "rolling cloud" that would destroy the world. The prediction echoed a song from the late 80s whose lyrics proclaimed "...the end of the world as we know it..."
