Wheaton College Christmas Festival: *O Holy Night* will air on *Sunday December 4 at 12:00 p.m. and December 25 at 12:00 a.m.* and will feature Wheaton's Woman's Chorale, Concert Choir, and Men's Glee combine to create an astounding array of sounds celebrating the spirit and true meaning of the season.
