



Tuesday, February 5 at 9 pm

Colin Smith hosts *Unlocking the Bible*, a daily radio broadcast to edify the Church. Colin is the senior pastor at The Orchard Evangelical Free Church. He mentors young pastors through The Orchard Network, an organization for growing gospel-oriented church leaders. Colin graduated from London School of Theology with a master's in philosophy.

Wednesday, February 6 at 9 pm

Jared E. Alcántara serves as associate professor of preaching at Baylor University's Truett Theological Seminary in Waco, Texas. An ordained Baptist minister, he earned a PhD from Princeton Theological Seminary. He is passionate about equipping students to minister effectively in diverse contexts and to preach in ways that are faithful, effective, clear, creative, and inspiring. His third book, The Practices of Christian Preaching will be published in 2019.


Saturday, February 9 at 4 pm
