

During the past six years, you have become family to Johanna and me. I could fill this entire newsletter with stories of how you have blessed our family.




This has never been more evident than in the last three months as we have been dealing with my mother-in-law's cancer. Your cards, gifts, notes, and prayers have touched us beyond words.

New at the Library



Martin Luther called the book of Romans “the very purest Gospel, and is worthy not only that every Christian should know it word for word, by heart, but occupy himself with it every day.” In *Comforts from Romans: Celebrating the Gospel One Day at a Time*, author Elyse Fitzpatrick makes the message of Romans readily accessible in 31 devotional-like chapters. Perfect for even the busiest people, Fitzpatrick helps us grasp the practicality of the gospel message and experience the deep comforts articulated in the book of Romans.

Anne Graham Lotz is the host of a recently added program on WRGN, *Daily Light for Daily Living*. Readers will be encouraged, uplifted, renewed and challenged in their spiritual walk with Jesus in her new book, *Fixing My Eyes on Jesus – Daily Moments in His Word*. While it is common to feel pulled in a thousand different directions, this book is a reminder to keep our hearts and minds focused on Jesus.

What Christ did at the cross remains central to our faith. Michael Card's latest book *A Violent Grace – Meeting Christ at the Cross* calls us to focus our attention once again on the cross. Explore the Old Testament prophecies and Gospel accounts of Jesus' self-sacrifice. Follow Jesus to the cross and realize anew that God's free gift of grace to us was purchased at the cost of inconceivable violence to his Son.

This, Easter, young readers will embrace the true meaning of the season with a new book by Crystal Bowman. In the book, *Lily's Easter Party*, Lily and her friends learn there is far more to Easter than jelly beans and chocolate bunnies when Lily's parents plan an egg hunt in the family's backyard. As they collect the hidden eggs, they realize that each egg holds a special symbol. As Lily's parents explain the meaning behind each item, the children discover the greatest Easter prize of all: the miraculous story of how Jesus died and rose again.

Also for Easter is *My Very First Easter Story* by Lion Children's Books. Portrayed in a colorful children's book is the story of Easter: the cheering crowds as Jesus rides into Jerusalem; the sad story of Jesus' crucifixion; and the joyful story of his resurrection, bringing good news for the whole world.

The Candle Library – Easter Collection includes six individual Bible storybooks in a slipcase. Each 8-page story is written with clear and simple text with charming illustrations. These books are just the right size for little hands to hold.
