

Resurrection...the Good News!

Our spring reading challenge for kids begins this month and we encourage them to write their name on a colorful spring flower and decorate the Library after they finish reading their books. If you're wondering what books other library members are reading, check out the display of recently returned items.

Fiction readers will enjoy the conclusion to Amanda Cabot's Texas Crossroads series, Book #3 is On Lone Star Trail and tells the story of Gillian Hodge, concert pianist, whose career was sidelined when a motorcyclist ran off the road and into Gillian. TJ Benjamin, high school history teacher, has been traveling the United States for the past year dealing with grief over his wife's death. When the two of them meet in Texas, this unlikely couple discover that their differences just might be what brings them together.

Joy Davidman is best know as C.S. Lewis' wife, made famous in the 1993 film Shadowlands. Don W. 




Despite the inclement weather, the WRGN Skate was enjoyable!
