



Last month we featured several Duck Commander books. Here are the remaining books and all are New York Times Best Sellers! Our sincerest thanks go to the Robertsons for making this very generous donation of books to WRGN.

Happy, Happy, Happy was written by Phil Robertson himself. Phil is known for many things: inventing the world's most realistic sounding duck call; playing ahead of Terry Bradshaw in college football and forfeiting a spot with the Redskins so he could hunt and fish; standing on his Bible-based principles and getting the media into a tizzy; and leading prayer before the meal, as the whole family comes together at the end of every Duck Dynasty episode.

You may have heard him allude to when he was "living in sin." This book will take you through living in poverty, fishing and hunting to feed the family, inventing the duck call, and living wild with drugs and alcohol. When he became a new creature in Christ, though, it was a true transformation! He now combines a duck call presentation with a Gospel message and speaks around the country. He has led thousands to Jesus Christ and has baptized hundreds in the river next to his house. That surely makes our Lord happy, happy, happy!


Good Call: Reflections on Faith, Family, and Fowl by Jase Robertson, is a fantastic choice to read next! Arguably, Jase is one of the two favorites of the show (Si is the other). We're used to Jase being

the straight man to Si's humor or being one of the slackers in the duck call room. In reality, Jase has been an incredibly hard worker from his very early years. Although Jase accepted the Lord at the age of fourteen, his earlier years were filled with fear and uncertainty, due to his father's drinking. Jase consistently found rest in the outdoors, where he became convinced there is a Creator. In this book, Jase is amazingly vulnerable, as he shares the many stages of his life. From his introversion that led him to drop speech class to his boldness that helped him successfully overcome teenage temptations and share his faith with others, Jase's story will touch the hearts of many, young and old!

The Duck Commander Family, written by Willie and Korie Robertson, is another great read! Willie, of course, is the salesman of the family and has taken the company to heights Phil never imagined.

Find out how Willie became a great salesman, how often he and Jase fought, how Korie's dad reacted when she announced their engagement, who sold stores to Sam Walton for his Sam's Club chain, where Korie and Willie's lives first intersected. Meet the kids, meet the family, and see how this dynamic duo is so well matched for each other. There's even a recipe included at the end of each chapter!


