

WRGN will once again have the pleasure of hosting a homeschool group at the flagpole right in front of the WRGN studios.



This month's featured author is **Warren Wiersbe**, a pastor, Bible teacher, conference speaker, and a prolific writer of Christian literature and theological

works. Wiersbe pastored Chicago's Moody Church and taught practical theology classes at Trinity Evangelical Divinity School. He has been writing books since the 1950s, completing more than 150 books. He is perhaps best known for his series of 50 books in the "BE" series of commentaries on every book of the Bible, including titles like *Be Real*, *Be Rich*, *Be Obedient*, and *Be Joyful*. The "BE" series alone has sold over four million copies! Wiersbe is one of our most popular "octogenarians" at the Good News Library, and we have a special display of many of Wiersbe's titles for you to discover this September.
